

Request to avoid use of images of specific children or young people.

Berkshire Orienteers has adopted a policy on photography at events which attempts to balance:

- (a) the freedom of people to take photographs of their friends or clubmates at events and for the use of photographs to promote the sport to the wider public, and
- (b) the protection of children and young people from intrusive photography and the inappropriate use of images

The club has adopted a policy on “**Guidelines for the Use of Images of Children/Young People under the age of 18**” which is available on the club website (<http://www.bko.org.uk/>) and photographers at events are expected to follow the Guidelines.

One component of the Guidelines is a provision allowing for people to request that photographers attempt to avoid photographing certain individuals when requested to do so. If you wish to make such a request, please complete the details below which will be passed to any BKO Registered Photographer attending the event. Please note that a separate request will be required for each BKO event.
