- Lynne and I also managed a Maprun training event for Maidenhead Athletics Club in Maidenhead last Sunday morning we had about 18 runners they seemed very keen we will run another Maprun event at Braywick Park in the new year starting at their HQ.

#### **Budget monitoring report 2024**

- The accompanying monitoring report shows we are performing well against the budget. The budget for the year forecasted a deficit of £1,400 but I now expect we will roughly break even by year end.
- Graham Johnstone has kindly agreed to be the independent examiner for our accounts again this
  year. Alongside the usual reports, I will be providing him with 'view only' access to our Club
  Treasurer software to check transactions.
- I will shortly be starting to 'build' the budget for 2025 so if anyone knows of any unusual income or expenditure plans, please let me know so I can take these into account. One thing to mention is that the BOF levies we pay on events is increasing so we will need to reflect this in the entry fees we charge.
- The club finances are in a stable position having taken account of depreciation. Our current assets have increased and therefore, we do have limited funds we could set aside for a project. The committee has discussed the need for website improvements during the year and may want to consider this in 2025 with the aim of attracting newcomers to the club.

#### Club Kit

• Trish has coordinated a number of requests from Club members and placed an order with Brysoz. We are not subsidising kit so the income from members buying kit should be in line with the purchase cost and I expect this to be approx. £1,100 - £1,200 dependent on delivery and taxes.
